Planning your installation or checking an existing setup?

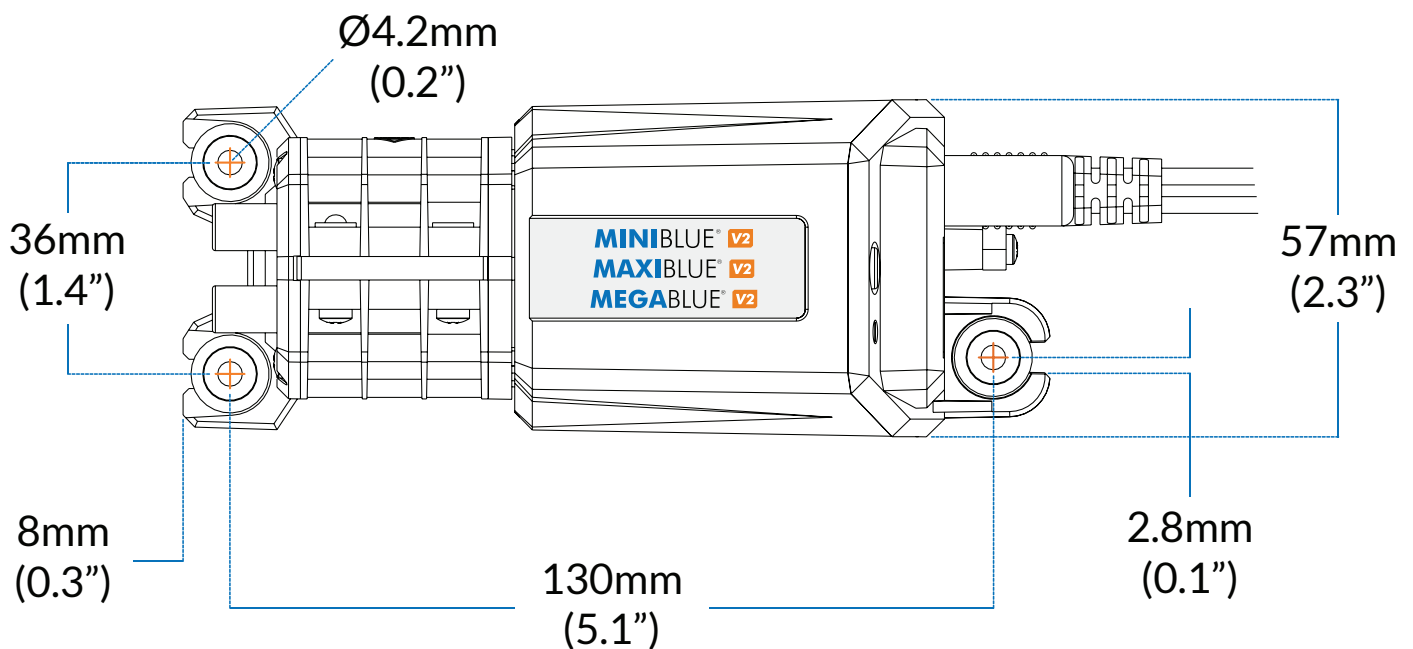
Explore the mounting detail below to understand recommended fixings and installation guidelines for reliable pump operation and future accessibility.



Installation guidance

Applies to all V2 Series models.

- The pump may be mounted in any orientation without affecting performance once installed.
- Install the pump in a dry, well-ventilated location and protect it from potential water ingress.
- The supplied screws and wall plugs are compatible with the mounting feet and may be used for remote installation where required.
- For optimum performance, secure the pump to a rigid, level surface to minimise vibration, noise, and mechanical stress during operation:
 - Maximum ambient air temperature: 35°C (95°F)
 - Minimum ambient air temperature: 5°C (41°F)
- When designing the discharge pipework, ensure the calculated system head remains below the pump's maximum rated discharge head.
- Consider both static lift and associated pipe run limitations in accordance with the discharge pipe chart.
